

## Safety information and

- Be mindful of various hazards when unloading and storing the shed.
- We recommend using a qualified installer or service provider.
- You must not be under the influence of alcohol or psychotropic substances while performing the work.
- Choose appropriate weather conditions for shed assembly. Work site may become hazardous during high wind, rain etc.
- The shed should be fixed properly to the foundation in order to protect it from strong winds. Storm protections (if included) should be assembled according to the assembly instructions.
- Make sure to use any tools and additional processes (e.g. coloring) according to their manuals when building the shed. To avoid any risk of electric shock, make sure power tools are safe for working outside.
- Wear work gloves, safety shoes, helmet, long sleeved and long-legged clothing items to prevent injuries caused by potentially sharp edges. Wear safety goggles for eye protection when using power tools.
- Keep children, animals and any outsiders away from the assembly site.
- Read general and product specific assembly instructions. In case of questions contact local seller
- Use appropriate safety equipment and be careful when working on the roof. Make sure the ladder is firmly on the ground. Never put all your weight on the roof or any other part of the shed.
- Corrosive agents and fuels must be stored safely in specially sealed containers.
- Make sure you do not make any drastic alterations to the construction of the shed so that it will maintain its original condition.
- Be mindful of your local laws and, if necessary, contact a construction supervision inspector.
- Use your common sense.
