4. Safety Warnings

General Safety Guidelines:

7. First Aid and Emergency Instructions

1. Skin Contact

- If the canvas material, frame, or any packaging causes skin irritation:
 - Wash the affected area with soap and water.
 - If irritation persists or there are signs of an allergic reaction, seek medical attention.

2. Eye Contact

- If dust, splinters, or debris from the product or packaging enters the eyes:
 - Rinse eyes gently with clean, lukewarm water for at least 15 minutes.
 - Avoid rubbing the eyes.
 - Seek medical attention if redness, pain, or irritation continues.

3. Inhalation

- If there are strong odors from the canvas or packaging materials during unpacking:
 - Move to an area with fresh air and ensure proper ventilation in the room.
 - If dizziness, headache, or breathing difficulty occurs, seek medical attention.

4. Ingestion

- If any material from the product (e.g., canvas fragments, frame pieces, or small parts) is ingested, especially by a child:
 - Do not induce vomiting.
 - Seek immediate medical attention and provide details about the material consumed.

5. Cuts or Splinters

- If handling the frame results in cuts or splinters:

- For cuts: Clean the wound with soap and water, apply an antiseptic, and cover with a sterile bandage.
- For splinters: Carefully remove with sterilised tweezers, clean the area, and apply antiseptic.
- Seek medical advice if the wound becomes swollen, red, or infected.

6. Fire Safety

- In the event of a fire involving the canvas wall art:
 - Evacuate the area immediately.
 - Use a fire extinguisher rated for Class A materials (ordinary combustibles) or call emergency services.
 - Avoid inhaling smoke or fumes.

Emergency Contact Information

 - If a medical emergency arises, provide responders with details about the materials and any chemicals used in the product.

9. Return Policy

Faulty or Damaged Goods:

- Contact the manufacturer immediately if a product arrives faulty or damaged.
